SPECIAL PROVISIONS OF THE EHC ORGANISERS

Further to the Title of Champion and the Trophies awarded by the FIA voluntary

m o n e y p r i z e s

from a common fund created by the organisers
of the competitions of the European Hill Climb Championship
will be distributed as follows:

Final general classification of each categories I and II

1st place	€	3'025.–
2nd place	€	1'925.–
3rd place	€	1'100.–
4th place	€	825.–
5th place	€	660.–
6th place	€	550.–
7th place	€	440.–
8th place	€	275.–

These prizes will be
increased by a bonus of € 5.–
for each point counted in the Championship.

The prize money is determined pro rata of the events held. The prize money mentioned here is for a season with 11 events. If events are cancelled, no prize money will be paid for them. The amounts are reduced according to the number of events not carried out.

Only the drivers who obtained at least a third of the maximum points to be retained at the end of the season will be included (maximum number of events retained, according Art. 5, to 25 points each).

Prizes must be collected personally by the driver at the end of season Awards Ceremony of the EHC Organisers. Uncollected prizes will be deemed to be not awarded.

In accordance with the decision of the Alliance of the EHC Organisers meeting on 14 February 2025 in Ljubljana/SVN, the **prize money will be transferred to the drivers** by bank transfer at the end of the year from the **2025 season (after the award ceremony)**. The drivers will receive a proforma cheque at the award ceremony.

Souvenir medals will be given to first 8 classified drivers and the winner of the Ladies Cup of each category (I and II).

Ladies Cup

A Ladies Cup will be given to the best female driver of each category (I and II), if the driver has participated in at least three events.
